Davey Moreton, a member of the Mariemont High School class of 2008, has been awarded a 2008 Marvin Lewis Scholarship.

The Marvin Lewis Scholarship Fund was created to recognize and honor outstanding male and female student athletes from our region on an annual basis. Candidates are asked to write a 1,000 word essay and to meet established criteria of a minimum 2.75 grade point average, proven commitment to the community and a varsity letter. Five males and eight females were awarded a four-year scholarship in 2008.

Moreton had recently signed with the baseball program at the University of Charleston in West Virginia. University of Charleston is a member of the NCAA Division II and the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC)
