Mariemont High School Sets Record for AP Scholars



Mariemont High School students from the Classes of 2008 and 2009 have set another record for the largest number of AP Scholars in school history. Forty-nine students at Mariemont High School have earned the designation of AP Scholar by the College Board in recognition of their exceptional achievement on the college-level Advanced Placement Program® Exams. The College Board recognizes several levels of achievement based on student's performance on the exams.

Langston Vonderheide (2008) was named a "National AP Scholar" by earning an average grade of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, **and** grades of 4 or higher on eight or more of the exams.

Twenty students qualified for "AP Scholar with Distinction" by earning an average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, **and** grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams. These students received an average grade of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, **and** grades of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.

"AP Scholars" are those students who received grades of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams. Students took AP exams in May 2008 after completing challenging college-level courses at the high school. Most of the nation's colleges and universities award credit, advanced placement, or both based on successful performance on the AP exams.
