

# Facilities Update Weekly

February 18, 2011

## High School:

- No new facility work going on at this time.

## Mariemont Junior High at Fairfax Site:

- The playground will be closed and removed during construction.
- Bids will be going out for Early Site Work, Foundations and Site Utilities. Bids are due February 22.
- Work for early site work will begin around March first.

## Mariemont Elementary:

- Bids will be going out for the Early Site Work and Demolition package Asbestos Abatement and for the Tower Crane.
- The modular building units have been arriving all week. The units must be connected to each other. They will be put on piers and anchored. The units are coming from Wooster Pike onto Plainville then brought down the church driveway by the tennis courts.
- There will be an **All-Parent Transition Meeting** on **Tuesday, February 22** in the auditorium at 7:00pm. The purpose of this meeting is to acquaint everyone with our plan for the transition to the modular units.

## Terrace Park Elementary:

- Electrical work on modular sites is finished in preparation for the modular units. The foundation for the buildings is ready.
- Bids will be going out for Early Site Demolition and Asbestos Abatement.
- Good news! We will be able to keep the playground open during construction. Turner Construction will be putting a fence around the playground so that it can be accessed from Marietta Ave.
- The modular building units will arrive at various times over the next few weeks. The units must be connected to each other. They will be put on piers and anchored.

- Teachers are packing, art work is being cataloged, packed or returned and we are cleaning our closets in preparation for the big move the week of March 25-April 3.
- We will be returning student art work that has proudly hung on the walls of Fairfax Elementary, Mariemont Elementary and Terrace Park Elementary Schools.
