Mariemont High School:

- The district maintenance crew is continuing to work on the Board of Education Offices. The Board of Education will be moving from the Junior High to the High School in late April/early May.

Mariemont Junior High in Fairfax:

- The exterior walls are being bricked.
- Electric, plumbing, and masonry work is being done on the interior.
- You can now see the roof over the gym and cafeteria areas.
- Second floor work is being done.

Mariemont Elementary:

- Masonry work is being done on the original building and in the new sections.
- HVAC, plumbing, and electric work continues in both the old and new sections.
- The exterior walls are being constructed and bricked.
- Second floor work is being done.

- Progress is quite visible. The clerestory (tower part) of the building is starting to rise above the lower levels.
- Second floor work is being done.
- HVAC, plumbing, and electric work continues in both the old and new sections.
