
Mariemont High School Profile 2024 - 2025



The Mariemont City School District, located in a suburb east of Cincinnati, is a public school district serving over 1,700 students from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds. The district strongly emphasizes academic excellence and promotes experiential learning through the award-winning Warriors BEyond program, with the goal of preparing students to be global learners and deeply committed members of the community and world. Matters related to school discipline are handled internally, and our policy prohibits public commentary on these issues.

Mariemont High School has been honored as a *Blue Ribbon School* four times, and 87% of our students are involved in one or more of our 60 clubs and activities. MHS adheres to the NACAC's Code of Ethics. The academic year consists of two traditional semesters with seven 50-minute class periods, commencing at 8:30 a.m. and concluding at 3:25 p.m.



ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Mariemont High School offers 22 AP courses and 8 honors courses. There is no limit to the number of AP courses a student can take.



COLLEGE MATRICULATIONS



The Mariemont High School Class of 2024 achieved acceptances from more than 115 institutions nationwide and secured a total of \$13 million in scholarships. 91% of the graduates opted for four or two-year universities, while the remaining 9% pursued technical programs or started their careers in various fields such as education, cosmetology, IT, veterinary medicine, and exercise science.

Warriors BEyond

Warriors BEyond is an award-winning experiential learning program at Mariemont City Schools. The program is designed to inspire and challenge students from kindergarten to 12th grade. Every spring. high school students participate in a 3-day Intersession and can choose one of three engaging options: take teacher-led courses, engage in handson career exploration, or go on college visits across the U.S.

As part of the Warriors **BEyond** experience, students can also enroll in a Master Class where they can create a personalized curriculum and earn elective credit to align their education with their passions. Outside the classroom, students have the opportunity to broaden their horizons by participating in academic or service-oriented international trips guided by the committed and adventurous faculty.
