



**Face Protection Exemption**

As we prepare to reopen our schools with the REBOOT Health Safety Protocols for the 2021- 2022 school year, the district will incorporate multiple layers of health protection for our students and staff. These recommendations and guidelines are drawn from current scientific knowledge of COVID19 and its spread. One precaution we will take is to require K-6 students to wear face protection.

We understand wearing face protection may not be medically possible for some of our students.
