Each 7-12 Online Warrior will be added to the "Schoolology" bootcamp course to help teach the platform they will be utilizing both in person and online.

Students should go to schoolology.mariemontschools.org and log in using their google accounts.

“My Day”

Wake Up: Online Warriors will be following a specific schedule, so while we all like to sleep in, the day will start just like in-person students!

On Time: Make sure you are on time for your first bell. Login into zoom using the link your teachers provided in Schoology. ** If you are late your teacher will mark you tardy.

Absent: If you are unable to make it due to feeling ill, contact the main office just as you would previously to notify them of your absence.

Schedule: Follow your personal schedule. (JH students will be sent an individual schedule prior to Monday). High school students can find their schedule on the student dashboard. (electives will need to be selected by the student in order to appear)

Bell 1 - 8:30-9:20. Language Arts.

**Zoom until the teacher gives additional direction, perhaps to work on the assigned activity. Complete Language Arts work.*

(stretch your legs, get water)

Bell 2 - 9:24-10:14. Math

**Zoom until the teacher gives additional direction, perhaps to work on the assigned activity. Complete Math work.*

(stretch your legs, get water)

Bell 3 - 10:18-11:08. Study Hall/Elective (Fuel Ed if applicable)

**Complete your Fuel Ed work*

(stretch your legs, get water)

Bell 4 - 11:15-12:05. Science

**Zoom until the teacher gives additional direction, perhaps to work on the assigned activity. Complete Science work.*

(stretch your legs, get water)

Lunch 12:07-12:48. You should eat also.

Bell 5 - 12:50-1:42. Study Hall/Elective (Fuel Ed if applicable)

**Complete your Fuel Ed work*

(stretch your legs, get water)

Bell 6 - 1:46-2:36. Social Studies

**Zoom until the teacher gives additional direction, perhaps to work on the assigned activity. Complete Social Studies work.*


(stretch your legs, get water)

Bell 7 - 2:40-3:30. Latin


**Zoom until the teacher gives additional direction, perhaps to work on the assigned activity. Complete Latin work.*

(Work on homework, charge your device, take a break)

**JH schedules will be similar for each individual student. A dedicated zoom time and work time, with breaks built into the day along with lunch.*



Our goal is to ensure our students, both in person and online, are at the same place using the same pace. That way, if and when we are ready to resume full time in person classes, all students are working together.

Questions:

When do I need to select my Fuel Ed Electives?

- Please complete the Fuel Ed selection form by Friday 9.2.20. We will not be adding your selection to your schedule until after the deadline. Fuel Ed electives will begin 9.9.20

Will my student continue to participate in Marching Band ? Orchestra? Choir?

-At this time our answer is yes, and we want our students to continue to participate in all that is available to them. For specific questions regarding instruments, attending band practice, etc.. will need to be addressed individually. Please reach out to your building principal directly for these answers.

How will live streams be accessed by our students?

-Teachers will share zoom links in Schoology for students to access. The students will be placed in the waiting room prior to being admitted to the class by the teacher as a safety precaution.

Will live streams be recorded?

- Yes, zoom will automatically record the live stream portion of a class period.

Will my online student's video be shown on the screen for the rest of the class to see?

- No, unless the activity calls for this type of interaction, but this would be communicated ahead of time (such as a student is giving a presentation to their classmates in speech class).

Which tier do we follow?

- Online warriors will follow the same tier as the school and adjust the times of their schedule, just as the in person students would. The order of classes will not change, only the times.

Device pickup if we did not attend phase in days?

- Students can pick up their device from the main office of their school.

Will a student be able to ask questions from home?

- Yes, students will be able to ask questions. The student's teacher will share how they would like them to ask for clarification, support, or other.
